Eagle River Coalition advocates for the health of the Upper Colorado and Eagle River basins through research, education and projects.

Eagle River Coalition (ERC) seeks a summer intern to support the Community Engagement Manager with Eagle River Coalition outreach and events, while also supporting the county-wide Beyond Lawn Program, a water efficiency program. These initiatives attract diverse people, make complex topics understandable and inspire action, enthusiasm and involvement in local watershed issues. This position will spend 50% of its time with Eagle River Coalition-specific outreach and events and 50% of its time supporting the Beyond Lawn program and will report directly to the Community Engagement Manager.

Key Responsibilities

Eagle River Coalition outreach and event support (50% of time):

- Support the Community Engagement Manager with summer Watershed Immersion events
- Organize and oversee outreach tabling events for ERC
- Support with outreach resource development
- Support Director of Watershed Restoration with river use study, including supporting with survey efforts
- Support with monthly monitoring of Brush Creek through River Watch and Post Assisted Log Structure (PALS) monitoring program
- Work alongside ERC staff to restore impacted riparian zones, with the use of volunteers, through revegetation, invasive species/ debris removal and trail work
- Participate in other ERC meetings, events and functions as appropriate
- Other duties as assigned

Beyond Lawn Program Support (50% of time):

- Support Beyond Lawn Program staff with Landscape & Irrigation Evaluations, which include site visits and creating reports
- Attend tabling and outreach events to represent the Beyond Lawn Program
- Support with coordinating and implementing summer workshops of Beyond Lawn, including but not limited to Rain Barrel, DIY Landscape and Irrigation Workshops
- Support with materials development for the Beyond Lawn Program
- Other duties as assigned

Specific Skills Required

- High school diploma or equivalent; some college preferred
- Passion for healthy rivers, streams, and waterways
- Proficiency with Word, Excel, and Google Suites
- Strong communication skills
- A willingness to learn, ask questions and expand skills as necessary

Personality that will thrive in this position: A reliable self-starter, a strong communicator, able to ask for direction and collaborate as part of a team. An individual genuinely interested in natural resources, the environment and conservation. Someone willing to work long hours outdoors in streams and wooded terrain as well as non-traditional hours connecting with and educating our community.

Other Details: This is a full-time position for approximately 12 weeks at \$21-25/hr (depending on experience), not to exceed 480 hours. The position will require working some nights and weekends. We may be able to work with the right candidate to develop a work schedule around existing summer plans and other commitments. Work may require some physical exertion, such as walking, standing, lifting (up to 50 lbs), carrying, or similar activities, sometimes in inclement weather. Please note - housing is not provided – *please be aware of local housing options prior to applying.*
